



List of craft materials for Lion King

If you joined us last week you may already have a lot of these items.

If not, these items can be found at the Dollar Tree

- Black electrical tape
- Pack of 4x6 craft foam
- Pack of 9x12 construction paper
- Scissors
- Tacky glue
- Ruler
- Single hole punch
- Yarn, any color
- 2 white paper plates
- Markers
- White card stock paper
- Stapler
- Curing ribbon, green and yellow but any color will work
- A bunch of flowers, I used purple, they come in a bunch any color will work, **the kids have an option instead of flowers they can use beads, feathers, pompoms, etc
- White coffee filters, not the cone kind

- 1 wooden clothes pin
- Chenille stems – pipe cleaners, any color
- Small spray bottle for water
- 7 Popsicle sticks
- 4 regular rubber bands
- Pompoms ½ inch
- Bag of google eyes
- 1 white poster board
- Plastic jewels or beads
- Glitter, if you don't mind the mess, it is not necessary 😊 but kids love it.
- 1 yellow poster board

Other items you might have around the house

- 3 toilet paper tubes, 2 for Monday and 1 for Tuesday
- Plastic bottle cap

Items you can get at a craft store, Michaels, Joann Fabrics, Hobby Lobby

- Yellow, white, brown, black acrylic paints
- Paint brush ½ inch
- 2 - 1" google eyes
- Gray and white craft foam
- Yellow, dark blue, medium blue, light blue, and red felt **construction paper can be used instead
- White fur
 - **construction paper can be used instead
- 1 red boa, if you bought a boa for last week and still have the remaining end, you can use that, the color doesn't matter.

These items can be found at places like Michaels, and Joann's Fabrics.

- Kid Safe Paint- Green, purple, black, blue, dark blue, white and teal. I like acrylic paints you can get them at Michaels or Joann's Fabrics or this set at [Oriental Trading Company](#)



Note: if you prefer your child(ren) not use paint, all the crafts can be done with markers or crayons.

- A fuzzy boa, not the kind with feathers, any color
- Two 12" dowels about 3/16"
- Optional 9x12 pieces of blue, dark blue white and black felt (the craft can be done with card stock or construction paper)
- A Pringles can at your local grocery store

I also suggest a drop cloth of some kind for the kids work area.
